# THE EVE STORY IS THE PRIMEVAL HUMANISTORY OF DECEPTIONAND DESIRE

#### SARA GROVES, GENERATIONS

# NOTICETHAT DECEPTION PRECEDES DESIRE; DECEPTION IS THE CRUCIAL ELEMENT

Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?"

### CLEARLY HERE, THE SERPENT/SIN HAS "SEIZED THE OPPORTUNITY AFFORDED BYTHE COMMANDMENT"

#### R.W.L. MOBERLY, DID THE SERPENT GET IT

[What matters here] "is not that the serpent's words are obviously false, but that they imply that a total prohibition is the sort of unreasonable prohibition that one might expect from God."

### INTRUTH, THE COMMAND WAS LIFE-PROTECTING, LIFE-AFFIRMING, AND LIFE-ENHANCING

# DESIRE BASED ON DECEPTIONAND MISREPRESENTATION ISTHE HEART OF EVE'S STORY

#### SIGVE TONSTAD, PAUL AMONG THE ECOLOGISTS

In Genesis, the serpent's misrepresentation of the command is thus intended to bring about distrust. The relational avalanche that follows the deception is shattering.

#### SIGVE TONSTAD, PAUL AMONG THE ECOLOGISTS

Misperception leads to distrust, distrust to alienation, and alienation leads to fear... For a predicament that sees the misrepresentation of God's command as the core problem,

cognizant that misrepresentation preceded violation, the solution will have to address more than the problem of violation. [It must address the underlying issue of trust!]

# YOU DON'T REALLY WANTHELAW FORBIDS, EVENIF YOUTHINK YOU

### IF YOU LONG TO HAVE THAT WHICH HE WHO LOVES YOU MOST AND KNOWS YOU BEST SAYS IS HARMFUL, YOU ARE DECEIVED

#### THE LAW IN WRONG HANDS

- "sinful passions aroused by the law" (7:5)
- "sin seized the opportunity..." (7:8)
- the commandment sprang sin to life (7:9)
- the commandment brought death (7:10)
- "sin seized the opportunity..." (7:11)
- sin used what is good to bring death (7:13)

# COMMANDMENT WASTAKEN CAPTIVE BEFORE

But we know that the law is good <u>if</u> one uses it <u>lawfully</u>.

# PAUL'S DETRACTORS IN ROME, LIKE THE SERPENT IN EDEN, WERE MISUSING THE

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death.

For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering.

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Now early in the morning He came again into the temple, and all the people came to Him; and He sat down and taught them. Then the scribes and Pharisees brought to Him a woman caught in adultery.

JOHN 8:1-11, NKJV

And when they had set her in the midst, they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman was caught in adultery, in the very act. Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned. But what do You say?"

#### JOHN 8:1-11, NKJV

This they said, testing Him, that they might have something of which to accuse Him. <u>But Jesus stooped down</u> and wrote on the ground with His finger, <u>as though He did not hear</u>.

So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, "He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first." And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground.

Then those who heard it, being convicted by their conscience, went out one by one, beginning with the oldest even to the last. And Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her, "Woman, where are those accusers of yours? Has no one condemned you?"

In Paul's account, as in Genesis... the 'sinner' is not only a villain. He or she is also a victim. This discovery redefines and expands the redemptive task.

### VILLAINS ARE GENERALLY SEEN AS DESERVING CONDEMNATION AND PUNISHMENT, BUT VICTIMS NEED COMPASSION AND HELF

### JESUS SHOWED US THAT GOD'S POSTURE TOWARD US IS ONE OF COMPASSION, NOT CONDEMNATION

### NOT ONLY IS JESUS NOT ONE OF YOUR ACCUSERS, HE DOESN'T EVEN HEAR THEM AND THEIR ACCUSATIONS

### WHENINTERNALAND EXTERNAL VOICES SHOUT CONDEMNATION, THE BEST PLACE TO BE IS ALONE WITH JESUS
